TRANSITIONAL WORK PROGRAMS

- Can often be as simple as a worker avoiding regular duties for a few days and then returning to those duties without restrictions which benefits the workers as well as the employers
 - If an employee misses work for six months due to a work-related injury/illness, there's a 50% chance the employee will return to work*
 - If an employee misses work one year, there's a 25% chance the employee will return to work*
 - If an employee misses work for two years, there's virtually no chance the employee will ever resume work*

*According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (1997)

- A work-site based program used for injured workers who are not able to immediately return to their regular duties
- A return-to-work program to assist an injured worker to return to their regular duties more safely and quickly
- Will incorporate modified/alternative duties during the period of recovery
